






- 1. Strip length, outer insulation = 35 mm (2-pole), 55 mm (3- to 5-pole)






We recommend pulling the pre-latched strain relief housing over the cable prior to termination. However, the strain relief can be mounted at a later time as well.



Latch the strain relief housing onto the plug /socket. Note the "TOP" inscription.



Prepare strain relief housing by snapping together upper and bottom part.



Tighten strain relief screw with screwdriver (2.5 mm blade width).
